Registration Information

Registration Fees

A registration fee of \$20 (\$15 Online registration) is required for all participants registering by Saturday, March 9, 2024. Some activities will require extra fees (this is indicated on the registration form), which should be submitted in addition to the registration fee. All fees must accompany the registration/waiver form for the participant to be eligible. The registration fee includes a Johnston County Senior Games T-Shirt and one (1) ticket to the Kick-Off Celebration and SilverArts Performance Showcase & Gala. If you wish to bring a guest to the SilverArts Performance Showcase & Gala, you can purchase one additional ticket at the time of registration.

Johnston County Senior Games is open to all Johnston County residents who are 50 years of age or older by December 31, 2024. A participant must be a North Carolina resident for a minimum of 3 consecutive months of the year.

Refunds

All refund requests must be submitted in writing no later than March 22, 2024. No refunds will be processed after this date. A \$5 processing fee is non-refundable.

Your age as of December 31, 2024 determines the category in which you will be placed for competition. Participants compete against others of their own sex and age as follows:

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General Information

- Photo ID will be required at all events each day. Participants are highly encouraged to arrive & check-in 15 minutes prior to their event.
- We request that every participant consult his/her doctor in regard to preparation for, and competition in, Senior Games or any similar activity.
- To promote total health and physical fitness, events of longer duration and lower intensity are strongly recommended. High-intensity types of activities are offered primarily for the conditioned, trained athlete.
- All activities will be held in a smoke-free environment.

Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the 2024 Edition of the North Carolina Senior Games Inc. Official Rule Book. Rules for all events are available at www.ncseniorgames.org or by contacting any of the local coordinating agencies.

Doubles Events

For any event that requires a partner(s), all people on the team **MUST** be a registered Johnston County Senior Games participant and must be indicated on the Registration Form. JCSG does not assign partners.

Partners may play down to a younger age group; the age of the younger player will determine the age group. A player may compete in only one age group in each event (i.e. can't play mixed doubles with two different people, etc.) If an individual's partner cannot come to State Finals, that person may select another partner who qualified in that sport at a Local Games in NC. A list of partners-seeking-partners will be posted on the NCSG website. The last day to change one's partner is the cancellation deadline. No changes may be made at the event.

Nationals

The National Senior Games are held every two years. 2024 is a National Qualifying year. State Finals 2024 will be the qualifying event for the 2025 National Games. See the Nationals page on the NCSG website at www.ncseniorgames.org/national-senior-games or www.nsga.com for more information.

Awards

In athletic events, each participant will receive a participant medal. In athletic events, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each age group, male and female, will receive a gold, silver, or bronze pin, which will be placed on the lanyard of your participant medal.

In SilverArts, Blue, Red, & White ribbon place winners in Visual and Heritage Arts will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. Blue & Red place winners in the Literary Arts will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. Best in Show in Performing Arts will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals.

State Finals qualification criteria returns to pre-covid with the exception of open events. The full qualification policy is as follows: The top three male and female qualifiers in each official North Carolina Senior Games sport/event in each age category will be eligible to participate in State Finals except:

- Bowlers: places 1-6
- Golfers must meet a minimum performance score (MPS) and finish in the top 3 in their age group. MPS is available from your Coordinator and in the NCSG Rules Book on the NCSG web site (www.ncseniorgames.org).
- All participants who complete a Local Games Fun Walk, Football Throw, Softball Throw and Basketball Throw will qualify.
- Teams: The first, second and third place teams per the team sport age category will qualify.
- In SilverArts, each Local Games may qualify:
- One entry in Performing Arts and the Cheerleader Showcase.
- First and second place in each Literary Arts sub-category, provided the places are not won by the same artist.
- First, second and third place entry in each Visual Arts and Heritage Arts sub-category, provided the places are not won by the same artist (i.e. only one entry by the same artist per sub-category).

SILVERARTS SHOWCASE

Please drop off art to the Smithfield Recreation and Aquatic Center between 9-11AM or 2-6 PM on Tuesday, April 30. If you need to make other arrangements, call Tiffany Pearson at (919) 934-2148. Work will remain on exhibit until 7 PM on Thursday, May 2. Artists are required to pick up their work after the SilverArts Performance Showcase & Gala on Thursday, May 2 from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM.

Limit of 3 pieces per sub-category

VISUAL ARTS

Sub-Categories: Acrylics, Drawing, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastels, Photography, Sculpture, Watercolor

- Entries must be the original work of the artist and must have been completed within 2 years of the Local Games qualifying date.
- All artwork, except sculpture, must be framed, securely wired, and ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Artwork, except sculpture, not properly wired will not be displayed.
- Artwork, except sculpture, can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- Sculpture groupings (sets) may have no more than 3 pieces per grouping (set).
- Mixed media may be a freestanding piece.
- Freestanding entries must be able to be displayed in an area 3' (W) x 3' (L) x 5' (H).
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible for delivery and pick-up of their entry at/during the designated times.
- If on-site assembly is required, details must be specified on the Information Form for NCSG prior approval.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- Artist must send a photograph of entry with State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned.
- The Visual Arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

HERITAGE ARTS

Sub-Categories: Basket Weaving, Crocheting, Jewelry, Knitting, Needlework, Quilting (Hand-stitched & Machine stitched), Stained Glass, Tole/Decorative Painting, Pottery (Thrown & Hand built), Weaving, Woodcarving, Woodturning, Woodworking

- Heritage Art must be an original work.
- Entries must be the work of the individual and not a group.
- Patterns may be used, but no stamped pieces will be accepted.
- Pottery must be hand built or thrown.
- Latch hook rugs and pieces from ceramic molds will not be accepted.
- All framed work must be securely wired, ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Two-dimensional work not properly framed and wired will not be displayed.
- Framed works can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- Groupings (sets) shall have no more than 3 separate pieces per set. All objects within each piece of the set must be contained within or attached to one of the 3 pieces of the set.
- All entries, except framed work, must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 5'(H).
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible for delivery and pick-up of their entry at/during the designated times.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- Artist must send a photo of entry with State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned.
- The Heritage Arts piece entered at State Finals must be the same piece that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

SilverArts Rules & Information

LITERARY ARTS

All entries must be received by March 9, 2024.

Sub-Categories: Essay, Life Experience, Poem, Short Story-Fiction

- All entries must be typed, double-spaced, on 8-1/2 x 11 paper and have a minimum of 1" margins. A minimum font size is 10-point type.
- Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- Short stories, essays, and life experiences can be no longer than 8 pages.
- All entries must have a title page, which includes title of work, sub-category, and name of artist.
- Artist's name should not appear on the content pages.
- The literary arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.
- A display-quality copy of the winning Literary Arts entries, and three (3) additional photocopies, should be submitted to NCSG by the artist with their official State Finals Entry Form and Silver Arts Information Form.

PERFORMING ARTS SHOWCASE

Thursday, May 2 at 4 PM—Smithfield Recreation and Aquatic Center

Sub-Categories: Comedy/Drama, Dance, Instrumental, Line Dance & Vocal

Format/Rules: Performing entries may be the following:

- Soloist (1 performer)
- Small Group (2- 4 performers)
- Large Group (5- 20 performers)

YOU MAY ONLY ENTER 3 ACTS TOTAL AND ONLY ONE IN EACH SUB-CATEGORY

- Performing entries are limited to three (3) minutes of on-stage time. Exceeding the time limit will result in automatic disqualification. Timing is the performer's responsibility and begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the final note of music or movement of the act.
- Performing entries may be one of the following: (a) soloists, (b) small groups (2 - 4 performers), or (c) large groups (5 –20 performers). Accompanist(s) will not be counted to determine size of act. No one under age 50 as of December 31st will be permitted on stage and an accompanist must be a registered participant.
- Props are the responsibility of the performer.
- At State Finals, all performers for all acts must enter stage right and exit stage left or begin and end on the stage. See the Silver Arts Manual for a stage diagram.
- If recorded music is used, it must be an mp3 file (submitted electronically or on a flash drive) or a high quality CD. Music must be sent with the State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. No recorded instruction is permitted. This should be the only track on the CD/flashdrive or electronic file.
- Artists should pick up their music after the performance because it will not be mailed/returned. Their music/song should be the only music on the CD.
- At State Finals, NCSG can provide the following items: Microphone(s), Piano, Sound system, and CD player. The act is responsible for all other props and equipment (including music stands, chairs, etc.) and must get NCSG advance approval for use at Show.
- Voice presentations must be a live performance by the artist. Background music can be recorded. Lip synch is not permitted as a performing art.
- The group leader, who must be a participant, must complete the Silver Arts Information Form for the group and submit it with their State Finals Entry Form, and each member of the group must submit their own personal State Finals Entry Form by the August 1st deadline.
- The performance at State Finals must be the same performance that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.
- No live animals are allowed, except for service animals.
